#### The Position

The Adult Basic Education (ABE) Level I Instructor will play a vital role in complementing our existing ABE program to be responsive to the needs of newcomers and individuals for whom English is not their first language. This will be accomplished through developing and facilitating foundational literacy and numeracy curriculum in alignment with provincial government standards and ESL principles via a variety of delivery methods including virtual, in-class and part/full-time.

### What You'll Do

- Develop lesson plans, activities and facilitate classes tailored to meet the diverse learning needs and goals of students, including newcomers and individuals experiencing marginalization.
- Collaborate with the current ABE instructor to ensure consistency, efficiencies and best practices are applied to both program streams.
- Contribute to the development of flexible, part-time and distance learning options for students.
- Design and implement interactive, community-based activities to enhance language learning.
- Integrate ESL strategies to support newcome students' language and academic development.
- Collaborate regularly with Employment Services staff, including the Classroom Employment Support Worker, to address students' holistic needs.



- Use technology and digital tools (e.g. smart TVs, tablets and similar devices, online learning platforms) to enhance learning.
- Maintain detailed records of student attendance, performance and progress for outcomes and evaluation purposes.
- Monitor and assess student progress through regular evaluations and individualized learning and support plans.
- Create a welcoming and inclusive classroom and alternative learning environment that respects and values cultural diversity, individual context and learning style.
- Attend professional development opportunities, including ESL-focused certification.
- As part of a co-instructional team, working closely to offer coverage and support to the other ABE cohort as necessary.

## What You'll Bring

- Post-secondary degree in Education.
- Minimum of 3 years experience.
- Experience teaching in non-traditional academic settings, particularly with diverse and marginalized populations.
- Experience with ESL learners is considered an asset.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite, including Excel, Word and Outlook.
- Demonstrated exceptional interpersonal and communication skills.
- Demonstrated ability in keeping accurate records and strong organizational skills.
- Ability to work and communicate effectively in a team environment.
- Knowledge of and experience in supporting those who have barriers to education.
- Strong understanding of mental health issues and you are comfortable working with individuals who may face complex challenges, ensuring a classroom and learning environment that is supportive, trauma informed, and recovery based.
- Criminal Record Check/Vulnerable Sector Check is required.
- Enhanced Reliability Status Clearance is required.
