Award-winning. Inspiring. Values-driven. Entrepreneurial spirit. These are some of the words that describe Stella's Circle, a leading social justice organization that works with over 1,500 people each year to help transform lives through housing, mental health, and employment.

The Position

The Family Social Worker will provide individual and group counselling to mothers who have experienced gender-based violence and been involved with the criminal justice system or who are at risk of being involved with that system. You will provide these services at the Newfoundland and Labrador Correctional Centre for Women (NLCCW) and in the community through the Just Us Women's Centre.

What You'll Do

- Completes intake assessments in community and prison to determine services that would be most helpful for women who are mothers or are pregnant.
- Provides individual counseling and facilitates therapeutic groups based on the needs of mothers. This includes delivery of grief and addiction groups.
- Gathers information on work with mothers with justice histories in other jurisdictions and helps build best practice.
- Refers mothers to other programs and collaborates with others as required, both within the organization and in the community, with consent from the participants.
- Regularly visits the NLCCW.
- Networks with other community, government and institutional staff who support the needs of mothers with justice issues.
- Identifies gaps in service and advocates at the appropriate government or agency level to effect change.
- Informs and educates others about the gaps and barriers encountered by mothers who have had justice involvement, including through presentations.
- Develops measurable goals and outcomes for services for mothers.

What You'll Bring

- Social Work degree and registered with the Newfoundland & Labrador College of Social Workers.
- Minimum of 3 years' experience in a mental health work setting including working with the target population of our program.
- In-depth knowledge of broad spectrum of community-based services, organizations and resources.
- Minimum of two years of experience counselling with individuals, with some experience in women, motherhood and/or criminal justice issues.
- Experience in counselling through group methods would be an asset.
- Valid driver's license required and access to a vehicle.
- Must be insurable on the company vehicle.
- Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check is required.
- Enhanced Reliability Status with Public Services and Procurement Canada is required.

The Details

This is a full-time contract position until March 31st, 2026. The work involves mostly day shifts but the position requires flexibility to work and stay overnight on occasion in the Clarenville area to provide services to the NLCCW. The salary range for this position is \$76,749.00 - \$83,254.93. Stella's Circle offers health and dental, long-term disability, life insurance, matching RRSP plan, sick leave, personal leave and three weeks vacation.
