The Position

An integral member of our Housing Services team, you will be joining a dynamic staff group whose work is critical to supporting the operations of the organization. As a Housing Resource Worker, your primary role is to provide support and guidance to clients who are seeking safe and affordable housing solutions while assessing and triaging resource centre drop-in clients. You will assist individuals in finding appropriate housing options and navigating various housing-related resources and services.

What You'll Do

- Conduct thorough assessment of clients' housing needs, preferences and circumstances.
- Identify any special requirements or challenges that may affect the housing search.
- Research and compile a list of available housing options based on clients' criteria.
- Assist clients in understanding housing listings, rental agreements and lease terms.
- Provide guidance on the application process and required documentation.
- Connect clients with relevant housing assistance programs, subsidies and community resources.
- Refer clients to social services, financial assistance programs and supportive agencies as needed.
- Develop individualized housing plans for clients, outlining steps and milestones for achieving stable housing.
- Maintain accurate records of client interactions, progress and outcomes.
- Follow up with clients to track their housing search progress and offer ongoing support.
- Educate clients about their rights and responsibilities as tenants.
- Advocate on behalf of clients to address housing-related challenges and ensure fair treatment.
- Provide information about eviction prevention strategies and tenant rights.



- Collaborate with local housing agencies, shelters, non-profit organizations and landlords to enhance housing options.
- Participate in community events and workshops to raise awareness about housing resources.
- Assist clients facing housing emergencies by providing immediate support and connecting them with emergency housing services.
- Maintain accurate and confidential client records and data in accordance with organizational policies.

What You'll Bring

- Bachelor's degree/diploma in social sciences, human services or a related field. Equivalent combination of education, training and experience will be considered.
- 3 years experience in a similar role.
- Knowledge of local housing market trends, housing assistance programs and tenant rights.
- Strong organizational skills and time management abilities.
- Excellent interpersonal skills.
- Effective communication skills, both written and verbal.
- Proficiency in record keeping and data management.
- Ability to work collaboratively in a team-oriented environment.
- Empathy and sensitivity when working with diverse populations.
- Eagerness to learn and take on new challenges.
