The Position

Under the direction of the Program Manager, you will be responsible for the assessment and provision of housing related supports to women and gender diverse people who have been involved with the justice system. Using a recovery, trauma, and gender informed lens, you will meet participants where they are and assess needs using a strengths-based approach.

What You'll Do

- Develop professional and caring relationships with the participants you are supporting.
- Assess housing needs and collaboratively create transition and support plans while participants are incarcerated.
- Support participants in all aspects of housing including: searching, system navigation, moving, landlord-tenant agreements, financial resources, and eviction prevention. Help participants move belongings and assist with housing-related appointments.
- Navigate housing and mental health systems and services with participants, supporting connection to external support options.
- Provide support at court when required.
- Liaise with other agencies who provide services and support to this population.
- Liaise and partner with landlords to arrange and maintain housing.
- Collaboratively develop a housing plan with participants outlining goals for success and the supports needed.



- Support participants to identify and develop their support networks, arranging additional supports as needed, based on housing plan and goals. Help prevent homelessness by identifying those as risk of losing their housing arrangement and intervening as needed.
- Focus on crisis-prevention through identifying strengths, supports, risks and developing action plans.
- Ensure all documentation, case management reports, and impact measurements are up to date and complete

What You'll Bring

- Have a post-secondary degree in a social sciences field such as social work, psychology or sociology. Equivalent combination of education, training and experience will be considered.
- Must be registered with appropriate governing body (if applicable) such as the Newfoundland and Labrador College of Social Workers.
- Have a minimum of 3 years' direct work experience with target population and/or the housing and homelessness sector.
- Have knowledge, understanding and commitment to the Housing First Model.
- Have knowledge and experience in: housing, homelessness, mental health, substance use health, recovery, harm reduction, trauma, and gender.
- Have experience in partnership-based programs and services with excellent knowledge of resources available.
- Experience with the criminal justice system considered an asset,
- Excellent analytical and problem-solving skills.
- Demonstrated skills in the areas of documentation, time management, attention to detail, communication, organization and interpersonal connection,
- Must have a valid driver's license, and access to a safe vehicle for work.
- A Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check are required for this position.
- Enhanced Reliability Status Clearance is required for this position.
- Travel outside the St. John's and surrounding area is required for this position.
- Must have a valid First Aid/CPR Certificate.



The Details

This a full-time contract position until March 31, 2026, with the possibility of extension. The hourly rate for this position is \$35.88. Stella's Circle offers health and dental, long-term disability, life insurance, matching RRSP plan, birthday leave, sick leave, personal leave and three weeks vacation.
