Emmanuel House is a 16-bed residential counselling program which offers help to people who are experiencing difficulties with addictions or mental health or have been involved with the justice system.

We are currently looking for a Night Support Worker (Relief) position. Under the direction of the Program Manager, the Night Support Worker offers support to the Night Counsellors, allowing them to attend to the counselling needs of the residents and other duties.

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Helping answer the door and telephone;
- Doing security checks of building as well as being alert to conflict or safety issues that may arise;
- Encouraging social/recreational activities;
- Modelling general health social interactions with residents.

The successful candidate will have a High School Diploma along with strong interpersonal and communication skills. Experience working with individuals with mental health issues, abuse, addictions and correctional histories would be an asset. A Certificate of Conduct is required. An Enhanced Reliability Status Clearance is required. The successful candidate must be able to work holidays and evenings.

This position will be Friday and Saturday nights with the possibility of relief during the weekdays.
