POSITION OVERVIEW

The candidate will have a strong background in choral conducting and vocal pedagogy. You will work closely with choir members to develop their musical abilities, build confidence, and create beautiful performances that reflect our organization's values and diversity. You will work within the existing robust volunteer culture of the Choir, supported by Stella's Circle staff to support member participation and stakeholder engagement in all of the Choir's activities.

- Plan and lead weekly one-hour choir rehearsals between September and June.
- Select a diverse repertoire that reflects the Choir's values and mission.
- Develop and implement inclusive and engaging teaching methods.
- Help recruit and direct a qualified collaborative accompanist for all choir activities.
- Prepare the choir for performances at community events and performances.
- Foster a positive and supportive choir environment.
- Collaborate with Stella's Circle staff and volunteers.
- Recruit and collaborate with other community arts groups and guest artists.
- Lightly support administrative work to facilitate performances in the community.

- Ability to work with and inspire individuals with varying skill levels and backgrounds.
